2. Matters Arising

Planning Application SMD/2021/0465 refused by SMDC.

3. Planning

- a. SMD/2021/0664 Conversion of three existing local heritage buildings to form a single dwelling house by Leek Cohousing Ltd on land off Thorncliffe Lane..

This matter was discussed at length.

The conclusion of the discussion was:

- The application is effectively a new build in the middle of a field outside a designated settlement area and not satisfying a local need.
- The alterations to the buildings and their surroundings will obscure their heritage, damaging what is attempting to be preserved.

It was determined that the application cannot be supported by the council. Clerk to write to planning.

- b. SMD/2021/0686 Demolition of existing flat roof garage and replace with new pitched roof extension. 37 Tittesworth Estate Blackshaw Moor.

There were no objections to this application. Clerk to write to planning.
